The documents filed at 80 purport to be an Answer, an Exhibit A to such Answer, a Certificate of Service, and an envelope in which the same were sent to this Court. They purport to be filed on behalf of more than 50 Defendants. They bear no signatures, nor any identifying addresses, nor any indication of the entry of an appearance of counsel. The Answer purports to be filed "as allowable by pro se law", with no elaboration as to what that is. None of the papers are compliant with the provisions of Fed. R. Civ. P. 11(a), which requires all pleadings to bear the signature of the attorney representing the pleader, or the signature of an unrepresented party. Further, settled law provides that a non-lawyer may appear only on behalf of themselves if they are a natural person. Given the facial non-compliance of these documents with these basis rules and principles, they are hereby STRICKEN from the docket and are of no further force or effect. Further, because these papers provide no means for the Court to serve this Order upon any of the involved Defendants, the Court ORDERS counsel for Plaintiffs to serve this Order upon all parties in this action via the substitute means previously authorized by this Court, and to promptly file a certificate of such service.
